TeraCopy installation instructions

This document will guide you through installing TeraCopy software on your PC. TeraCopy may be downloaded for free from <u>https://www.codesector.com/teracopy</u>.

Note: These instructions are designed for users running Windows 7 or Windows 10 using the Firefox internet browser. If you are using a different browser, the process of downloading and installing TeraCopy may be slightly different.

The mouse instructions refer to a conventional mouse layout, where the left button is the primary button:

Left-click means a single click of the primary mouse button. Right-click means a single click of the secondary mouse button. Double-click means two left-clicks in rapid sequence.

1. Download and install TeraCopy 3.26

1.1 Follow this link: https://www.codesector.com/teracopy.

1.2 Left-click the red **Download** button.

1.3 In the dialogue box, click Save File. Firefox normally saves downloads automatically in the Downloads folder.



1.4 Open **File Explorer** (in Windows 10) or **Windows Explorer** (in Windows 7) by typing **File Explorer** or **Windows Explorer** into the search bar of the start menu.
